## Internal Lay-out at Spencer Works—Llanwern

Referring to Notice No. W.844 dated 21st July, 1960, as from the 17th APRIL, 1961, the Spencer Works Service Lines will be connected through and will connect with the Relief Lines near Bishton Level Crossing and near the 156 m.p. (near the overbridge replacing the former Lliswerry Level Crossing). The east end connections will be operated from Magor Signal Box and the West end connections will be operated from East Usk Panel (see Notice W.900 dated 1st April, 1961).

The internal lay-out will be as shown on sketch on reverse.

A stop board will be provided on each of the East and West Ingoing Works Lines (Down and Up Service Lines respectively) at a point 500 yards ahead of the catch point. An engine, 60 wagons and brake van, will stand between the stop board and the catch points.

One or more trains may be admitted to the Ingoing Works Line.

Movements beyond the Stop Board will be made under the supervision of the staff of Messrs. Richard Thomas & Baldwins Limited, who will also act as conductors when necessary.
