Between Saturday 7 and Wednesday 11 May, 1977

The Junction will be brought into use in the form shown on the diagram overleaf.

The Up Loop will be brought back into use.

The following signals will be brought back into use :-

- Up Loop Home 46 yards further from the signal box.
- Up Loop Distant 276 yards further from the signal box (The AWS inductor will be repositioned accordingly).

In connection with the singling of the Up and Down Main, the Up Main Home signal will be recovered.

The present Up Main Starting signal for Frome North will be controlled additionally from, and will also act as the Up Main Home for, Clink Road Junction. The lower Inner Distant on this signal will become the Distant signal for Clink Road Junction Up Main Starting signal.

The Up Main Distant signal for Clink Road Junction will remain, as at present, as the lower arm on the Frome North Up Main Home signal.

Track circuits will be re-arranged accordingly.
