NOTICE TO TRAINMEN ETC.SIGNAL ALTERATIONSSLOUGHSATURDAY 29 JULY TO SUNDAY 30 JULY 1978

Between 22.45 hours on Saturday 29 July and 20.00 hours on Sunday 30 July 1978 or until completion, the Divisional Signal and Telecommunications Engineer will be engaged in carrying out the following work:-

The Down Main Signal (S22) and associated A.W.S. inductor will be recovered and routes to Down Relief and Up Relief L.O.S. will be transferred to signal S20.

Signal S20 will be equipped with a new position four junction indicator.

The revised routing for signal S20 will be as follows :-

- S20A - East Loop (main aspect/position one J.I.)
- S20B - East Loop (Draw Ahead).
- S20C - Down Main (main aspect)
- S20D - Down Relief (main aspect/position 4 J.I.)
- S20E - Up Relief L.O.S. (Draw Ahead)

Occupation of the Signalling Panel will be required for the purpose of testing.

All arrangements for the safe working of the line, together with the appointment of any Handsignalmen required in accordance with Section E of the Rule Book will be made by the Area Manager Slough.
